

Have stored in a safe location:

- 1. More than 72 hours supply of food and water
- 2. Reserve pharmaceutical supply for 2-3 weeks
- 3. Several flashlights with extra fresh batteries
- 4. Antibiotic ointment and dressings/bandaids
- 5. Battery or hand crank operated radio
- 6 Tarps, plastic or wood to cover holes in roofs, walls, or windows Thanks, Laurel Stoner
