

THE NEXT BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

The next Board of Directors meeting is on Thursday July 11th at 7:00pm.

The agenda for all board meetings is posted in advance at the entrance to the Clubhouse. Monthly meetings are open to all homeowners. The 15-20 minute *Open Forum* session at the start is a great opportunity to have any issues heard by the board, the association manager, and others present, and to ask questions about any projects or decisions that have been addressed by the board.

Following *Open Forum*, the meeting is limited to those issues posted on the agenda. Homeowners are welcome and encouraged to stay and observe, but this part of the meeting is closed to owner participation. Minutes of all meetings are posted on the website after they have been approved at the next board meeting.

There remains one vacant seat on the board for the term that expires early next year. The board is currently deliberating how to fill this vacancy.

This warm weather is the perfect for adult residents and families alike to enjoy our two sparkling swimming pools! As schools break for summer, please remember that for insurance and safety reasons children under 18 must be accompanied to the pool by an adult resident at all times. Remember to be considerate to the neighbors living around our pools and to other pool users – please no loud music, running, shouting or screaming.

Also, for health and safety reasons, infants in swim diapers are not allowed in the water. Please be sure to review the other posted pool and hot tub rules. If you need a key for the large pool or the new key fob for the small pool and Clubhouse contact Luis at CMS. Pool hours are 10am to 10pm.

Guests must be accompanied by their resident host at all times with a maximum of 4 guests per unit. Please do not leave your guests alone at the BBQ area or poolside.

The Summer Pool Party for Vineyards residents will be held 3 – 7 PM on Sunday July 14th, at the big pool. We will be serving chips & dips, burgers, hot dogs, veggie-burgers, salads and watermelon. Please, if you bring your own wine glass or beer tankard, remember to use only acrylic or plastic glasses poolside.

NEXT DOOR

In January the City of Saratoga started using Nextdoor.com to communicate city news and events within Saratoga. The Vineyard's has it's own neighborhood network within this scheme, which only allows Vineyard's residents to register – through Nextdoor we can receive emergency alerts from the city of Saratoga, as well as access to information about community events and local businesses, etc... As we go to print, 21 out of 165 households have already joined Nextdoor Vineyards of Saratoga. FROM THE LANDSCAPE COMMITEE

Citrus Fruit: In the last couple of years we have planted more citrus trees around the Vineyards in response to requests from residents. These trees are still young and small, and are bearing limited amounts of fruit. Everyone is free to partake of the fruit, however, when you do, please limit your harvest to one fruit at a time. Please leave the rest for your neighbors, who also love to be able to walk out their front door and grab a lemon or lime for their favorite drink or dish. If you need more, please make a trip the grocery store. Gene's would love to provide you with all that you need.

Please be kind and share with your neighbors.

Dogs & Damaged Lawns: There are a lot of dogs at the Vineyards and we are experiencing a real problem keeping some areas of our grass from dying due to dogs urinating. You'll notice unsightly brown, dead spots in our lawns. These are areas where dogs (especially females) prefer to go and where owners seem to congregate. It is ugly to look at, and we've had to re-sod some areas – this gets expensive. If you have a dog, please be considerate where you walk it when it's time to go.

A couple of suggestions you might try:

- Take a bottle of water to dilute the urine on grass, as this helps the roots recover. The first time in the morning is especially strong.
- Use some of the more accessible dirt areas, around large trees and towards the back on the perimeter.

Please be considerate to the next dog and owner to come along and to all other residents – always use poo bags and pick up, even when your dog goes in the ivy or on the dirt or leaf layer along the creek!
