<u>ITEM I</u> - Call to Order – President Jim Foley called to order the Board of Directors meeting at 7:09 PM at the association's clubhouse.

ITEM II - Open Forum

Gia Biagi was present to address the Board regarding the Welcoming Committee.

Nilda Retamoso of 19430 thanked the Board for repairing the light, but wanted to inform the Board that the area in front of her garage was too dark. Jim Foley and a few others indicated other areas which could use more light. The Board would inspect the community to come up with a list of areas for more lighting.

Michael Toback indicated the termite report from 19123-19124 required attention.

Anna Scicinska requested the large Eucalyptus branch new her home be inspected by the Landscape Committee.

ITEM III - Review and Approval of the Minutes

A. The Board reviewed the minutes from September 13, 2016 Board of Directors meeting. Gloria Felcyn made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Laurel Smith seconded the motion and the motion carried.

ITEM IV - Committee Reports

A. Financial Report - October 31, 2016

The Board of Directors reviewed the current reconciliations and account statements of the Association's operating and expense accounts for the past month, the operating and reserve revenues and expenses compared to the current year's budget, as well as the income and expense statement of the Association's operating and reserve accounts. Gloria Felcyn reported on the YTD for 2016 operating account as of November was \$627,000.00 and the YTD actual was \$641,912.36. Total YTD reserves of \$2,372,617.72. YTD deficit as of November \$10,238.98.

The Board of Directors reviewed the aging report for September 30, 2016 and noted no changes.

The Board reviewed the request from the owner of 19220 to waive the late fees and interest due to an oversight on the owners part due to having autopay. Jeff Klopotic made a motion to approve waiving the late fees and interest for the owner of 19220 in the amount of \$98.00. Jim Foley seconded the motion and the motion carried.

B. Security

- Kailash Joshi reported on the sample LED lights on the entrance and exit to the community to allow for more light for recording license plates. Jim Foley made a motion to approve the install of the new LED lights but to have them installed overlooking the walls to each side of the entrance and exit. Jeff Klopotic seconded the motion and the motion carried.
- Kailash Joshi also informed the Board of the sand blasted sign to be produced by San Jose Sign. Michael Toback made a motion to approve the wood sign as presented. Laurel Smith seconded the motion and the motion carried for a total reserves expenditure of \$1,500.00.

C. Welcoming Committee

Gia Biagi presented the Board with a copy of the welcome packet to be presented to new owners. The Welcoming Committee requested a list of the new owners that had moved in to the community over the past 3 months.

D. Maintenance

Tom Schmidt informed the Board of the proposal for replacing the short wooden posts to protect the PG&E meters with metal bollards. The motion was seconded and carried.

- The Board discussed revamping the irrigation system but it would be very difficult to determine what part to replace unless it was failing. Chris Burns would speak with Tim Dooling for his opinion.

F. Governing Documents

- The Board discussed the letter from Jeff Barnett as to the preparation of the ballot for the approval of the restated governing documents. The Board needed to determine the date for returning the ballots and whether it would include an extension. Laurel Smith made a motion to have the ballots for the restated governing documents by March 15, 2017 at 5pm and to open and count the ballots on March 16, 2017 at noon at the offices of Community Management Services, Inc. Michael Toback seconded the motion and the motion carried.
- Laurel Smith made a motion to appoint CMS as the inspectors of election for the tabulation of the ballots for the restated governing documents. Michael Toback seconded the motion and the motion carried.

• The Board agreed to present a \$10.00 gift card from Gene's to the first 75 ballots returned on January 21, 2017. The Board also agreed to include the first 75 owners to return their ballots for a raffle of a \$100.00 gift card to Gene's.
