#### THE NEXT BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

The Board meeting will be held on Thursday May 9th at 7:00pm.

The agenda for all board meetings is posted in advance at the entrance to the Clubhouse. Monthly meetings are open to all homeowners. The 15-20 minute Open Forum session at the start is an opportunity to have any issues heard by the board, association manager, and others present, and to ask questions about any projects or decisions addressed by the board.

Following Open Forum, the meeting is limited to those issues posted on the agenda. Homeowners are welcome and encouraged to stay and observe, but this part of the meeting is closed to owner participation. Minutes of all meetings are posted on the website after they have been approved at the next board meeting.



The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) academy trains residents to prepare for and respond to disasters in their community. Some of the skills taught include personal preparedness, organizing resources, basic medical operations, basic search and rescue, how to use a fire extinguisher and basic damage assessment.

The Vineyards is designated as a CERT division within the City of Saratoga. In the case of a disaster, we may be dependent on ourselves for a time. We have a few members that have completed the training but we could use more. Saratoga will be hosting an academy in April/May. It's fun and very informative. Anyone can do this!

The Saratoga CERT Academy is 6 nightly sessions and a final skills exercise.

Saratoga CERT classes are held on Tuesday and Thursday nights, from 6:00pm-9:00pm, on the following dates - 4/30/2019, 5/2, 5/7, 5/9, 5/14, 5/16 and the final class and graduation on Sunday 8:30am-12:30pm

A \$35.00 Fee covers participant's safety equipment and training material.



Re: Neighborhood Watch Program

When: Clubhouse on Saturday, May 4 at 10:00 AM.

Do you have items in your home that are valuable to you? Like perhaps money, electronics, your grandmother's necklace, your Dad's wedding ring or other sentimental items. Family heirlooms or sentimental items cannot be replaced.

There has been a rise in package burglaries, mailbox break-ins, home and vehicle break-ins in Saratoga. Vehicle burglaries were at **14** for 2017 - in 2018 they rose to **34** in Saratoga. There were more residential burglaries in 2018 over 2017 as well. Highest times for residential burglaries are **Saturday 11-12 pm** & 9-10 pm, Friday 3-4 pm, Monday 5-6 pm, Wednesday 12-2pm and Thursday 11-12 pm & 12-2 pm.

Here at the Vineyards, we have experienced multiple mailbox breakins and vehicle break-ins. Even if only minor items are stolen, dealing with the aftermath can be difficult and time consuming!

What can our community do to prevent becoming the next victim?

How: Attend a Neighborhood Watch Kick-off meeting with one of our wonderful County Sheriffs for about an hour and become part of Neighborhood Watch. You will receive a Neighborhood Watch Window Decal that indicates your home is being watched. The more decals, the bigger deterrent it will be.
